## 7) To discuss any planning matters to hand

**Determinations:** 

Permission to erect single-storey side extension at Kirby Cottage, Langham Road Permission to convert two-storey barn to residential use and erect three bay cartshed garage at Old Barn Farm.

4 Field Dalling Road – lawful development certificate granted for work previously undertaken.

New Application – Erection of 1<sup>st</sup> floor rear extension at 39 Warham Rd – resolved no comment.

#### 8) To discuss speeding in Hindringham Road including *Speedwatch* and *SAM2*

Since the last meeting DF had placed a notice in *Local Lynx* to see if there would be any interest in starting a local *Speedwatch* scheme. This was expected to be published in the next few days. KL had spoken to highways who had agreed to paint "slow" on the road when the weather is warmer. However, they were not able to provide any other signage. Norfolk County Council is currently operating a scheme to fund 50% of the cost of *SAM2* units. These flash up the speed of vehicles that are travelling too fast with the words "slow down". The approximate cost is £3000 (which we could not afford) but we could manage £1500 if we qualify for the grant. The closing date is the end of January. It was resolved that we try to obtain a grant-aided unit.
